ARTICLE 1

The NASCECME AWARD is designed to distinguish outstanding works and/or initiatives by professionals and students in the area of Material and Sterilization Center (CME) focused on improvement and safety actions to health care at the material and sterilization center (CME). The NASCECME AWARD was created to commemorate the 200th anniversary of the birth of Florence Nightingale. The works should associate Florence Nightingale's environmental theory with a focus on risk-free care, expressed, strongly in the environmental theory that brought the clear relationship between human beings, health, the environment, nursing care in professional practice, teaching experience, student or scientific study.

ARTICLE 2 - PARTICIPANTS

All nursing professionals working in the Material and Sterilization Center (CME), other professionals involved in the processing of health products, students from related areas from public, private or philanthropic institutions, can participate for the NASCECME AWARD of the CME service, in Brazil and abroad. At least 1 (one) of the authors must be working in the practice of CME. Each author may send a maximum of 3 (three) works. The maximum number of authors will be 5 (five) per submitted work.

ARTICLE 3 - WORK

The following types of works may be registered:

Original works: Original and empirical, experimental, conceptual, qualitative or quantitative research, discussion and interface with national and international scientific literature.

Reviews: Analysis of quantitative or qualitative studies that aim to search for evidence. Critical, comprehensive and systematic evaluative studies, resulting from original research, carried out exclusively on secondary sources.

Experience reports: Study that describes individual or group experiences related to care, teaching, research and management/management in the field of health, nursing, education and related areas.

Theoretical study: Analysis of theoretical constructs, making it possible to question existing models.

Abstract of thesis or dissertation: Abstract extracted from work concluding a master's or doctorate course.

The author(s) must comply with the following order for sending the work: identification sheet, summary, introduction, objectives, method, results, conclusions and references.

The identification sheet must contain the full name, CPF (for Brazilians), e-mail address and institution of the author(s).

The author(s) must, at the time of registration, select the classification in which the respective work fits: original works, reviews, experience reports, theoretical study, and abstract of thesis/dissertation.

Abstracts should be sent with the following text structure: *title, objectives, method, results, conclusions, keywords, references.*

The *abstract* must come on a separate page from the body of the paper and without identifying the authors or institution(s) involved.

The *abstract* can be written in Portuguese, Spanish or English according to the origin and native language of the author(s). The abstract should originate from work of outstanding initiatives and be described in a maximum of 1.000 words, excluding references. The work must be sent in full upon registration.

The study should not exceed 15 pages, (A4 - 21,0 x 29,7 cm), including the abstract, tables, illustrations and references.

The title must contain a maximum of 18 words.

The text must be typed in the Word for Windows software, Arial font, 1.5 line spacing.

In addition to the text, attachments, illustrative photos of the project, tables and/or graphics will be allowed, as an attachment.

ARTICLE 4 - REGISTRATION

Entries will be made by filling out a registration form on the website: www.nascecmec.com.br/premio including: full name, CPF (for Brazilians), electronic address and institution of the author(s). The author(s) must, at the time of registration, select the classification in which the respective work fits: *Original works, Reviews, Experience reports, Theoretical Study, and Summary of thesis or dissertation*.

The complete paper must be sent, in a specific form, by e-mail, until **November 30, 2020**, to the electronic address: premio@nascecmec.com.br, in a file with the extension .pdf.

If the work involves human beings, it must have its approval by the Research Ethics Committee of the institution where it was carried out, or via Brazil platform, under the guidance of the National Research Council of Resolution 466/2012.

The regulations are available on the website: www.nascecmec.com.br/premio.

After receiving the registration form, the candidate will receive, in his/her email address, the registration number of his/her work.

ARTICLE 5 - EVALUATION

The evaluation and classification of the works will be carried out in two stages.

First Stage: Verification of the conformity of the material sent with the specifications established by this regulation. Papers that exceed the number of 15 (fifteen) pages will be disqualified.

Second Stage: Analysis of the works by the judging committee. The works will be evaluated for originality, contribution to the category of Nursing, conformity with a scientific work in addition to the relationship with Florence Nightingale and his Environmental Theory.

ARTICLE 6 - THE JUDGING COMMITTEE

The prizes will be awarded by a jury chosen by the NASCECME board of directors consisting of five nursing professors, of recognized experience, representing the five regions of Brazil.

ARTICLE 7 - AWARDS

The classified works will be distributed in three classifications according to their relevance, impact on practice and actions that can be shared for patient safety.

1st Place: Impact action for patient safety.

Complimentary registration for the face-to-face events of the NASCECME Group + Plaque + Diploma of recognition.

2nd Place: Book “Esterilización de Productos Sanitarios” + Diploma de reconhecimento.

3rd Place: Diploma as Honorable Mention.

The work classified in **1st place** may also be published in an Edition of the *Journal Infection Control, 2021*, after adjusting it to the publication rules (<http://jic-abih.com.br/index.php/jic/index>) provided it is of interest to the authors.

ARTICLE 8 - GENERAL GUIDELINES

Regarding the jury’s decisions, no appeals or complaints will fit.

Omitted cases will be resolved by the NASCECME Board in conjunction with the judging committee.

Doubts that cannot be resolved by the provisions of this regulation will be submitted to the judging committee under the coordination of NASCECME, whose decisions will be sovereign and unappealable.

November 30, 2020: Deadline for registration and delivery of completed papers.

January 10, 2021: Disclosure of the awarded works on the page **www.nascecme.com.br**

January 31, 2021: Delivery of the Awards in the city of São Paulo.
